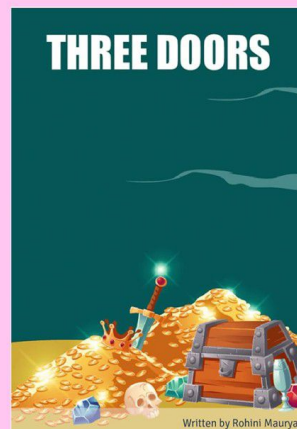
Ms. Ruma Malhotra was appointed by CBSE as the resource person for this Workshop which was attended by 50 teachers from in and around Dehradun.

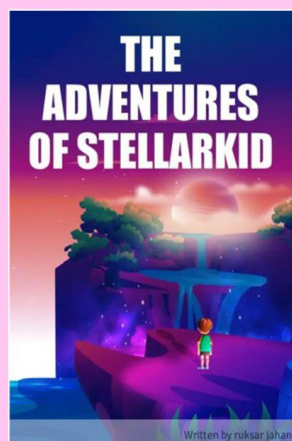

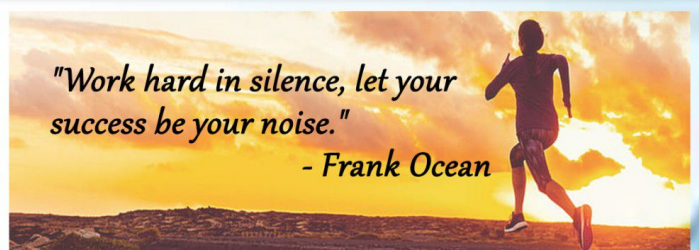

The workshop covered everything from understanding host plants, butterfly rearing, and creating butterfly gardens.



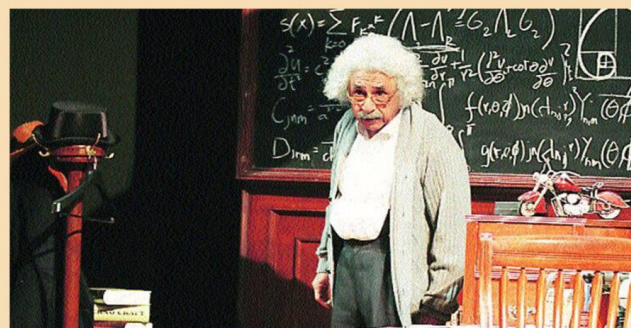
### *Learning beyond the classroom*
