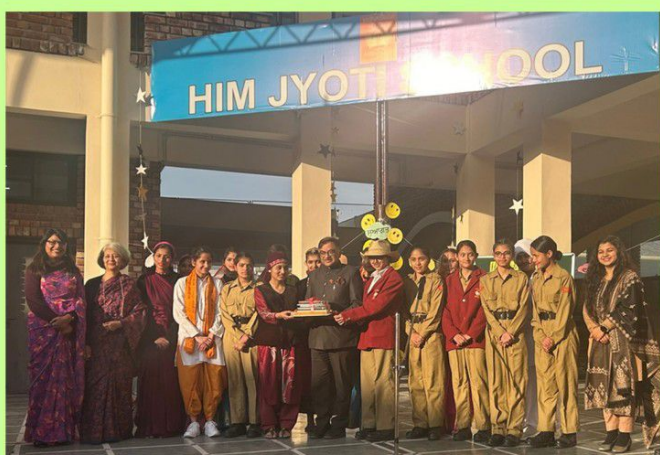
Celebrating Linguistic Diversity at Him Jyoti School
